Whit Merrifield Named to All-Star Game

Whit Merrifield, Kansas City Royals star, was named to his first MLB All-Star Game last night. He will represent the Royals at the 2019 All-Star Game on July 9 at Progressive Field in Cleveland, OH. Merrifield was voted to the American League team by a players' vote and the Commissioner's office. It is his first All-Star appearance.

Merrifield is currently hitting .301 for the Royals and is second in the league in hits with 106. He also led all of Major League Baseball in hits and stolen bases in 2018.

The 2019 All-Star Game will be televised nationally by FOX.
