TWC Lands Two Day-One Picks During 2019 MLB Draft

The Warner Companies Sports Management Team represented two players that were drafted on day one of the 2019 MLB Draft.

Shortstop Will Wilson was drafted 15th overall by the Los Angeles Angels. He has agreed to terms with the team, receiving a signing bonus of \$3.4 million. A 2019 Baseball America First-Team All-American, Wilson led the NC State Wolfpack with a .335 batting average, 20 doubles, 16 home runs and a .661 slugging percentage. He has reported to the Orem Owlz to begin his professional career with the Angels organization.

The Warner Companies Sports Management Team also represents Alec Marsh who was drafted 70th overall by the Kansas City Royals. Marsh will receive a signing bonus of \$906,800 from the Royals. A right-handed pitcher out of Arizona State, Marsh had a strong junior season for the Sun Devils, going 9-3 with a 3.17 ERA with 92 strikeouts and 33 walks in 96 2/3 innings.
